Introduction

For some operations you can choose a kind of anaesthetic called a spinal. This leaflet tells you about having a spinal anaesthetic at Melton Hospital.

Choosing your anaesthetic

Your nurse at the pre-assessment clinic will tell you if your operation can be done with a spinal. You will be given a leaflet about having a spinal and a leaflet about having a general anaesthetic. Please take time to read them both and think about which anaesthetic is best for you.

If you have any questions the team at Melton Hospital will do their best to answer them.

Important things to know about spinals at Melton Hospital

- Some people are offered a spinal but they are not offered a general anaesthetic at Melton Hospital. Your nurse will talk to you about this at the pre-assessment clinic.
- If you choose a spinal, you may still need a general anaesthetic. This is explained in the leaflet 'Your Spinal Anaesthetic'. If you have any questions about this, please ask.
- If your anaesthetist cannot do the spinal when you come for your operation, we may
 arrange for you to have your operation on another day at Leicester's Hospitals. It is
 important that you understand this before you choose a spinal at Melton. If you have any
 questions about this, please ask.
- On the day of your operation you will meet your anaesthetist. They will talk to you about your choices. You can ask them any questions you have.

After you go home

Spinals are not new, but they have only been a choice at Melton since 2023. If you have a spinal we would like to contact you 2 or 3 days after your operation. This is to ask you about your experience so that we can improve our service.

Please tell your nurse if you do not want to be contacted.
